

One Touch Park and Pickup

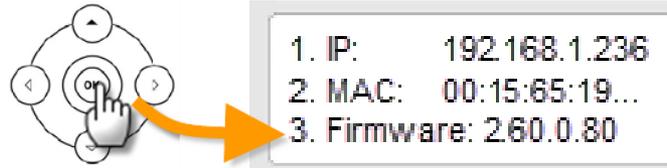
For the Yealink T-28*



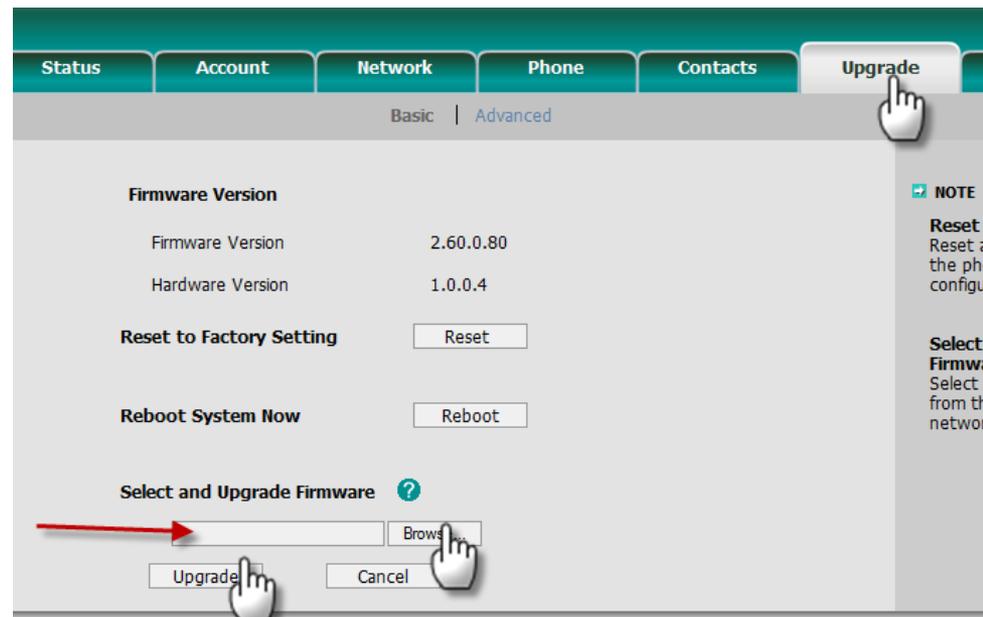
* for other models, follow similar steps

Step 1 – Make sure your Yealink T-28 firmware is version 2.60.0.80:

- Press the “OK” button on your phone to see the Firmware version:



- If your firmware version is NOT 2.60.0.80, log into your Yealink web portal and upload the new firmware, found at <http://www.yealink.com/index.php/Support/>



Step 2 – Add “Call Park” and “Company Line” to your Line buttons:

- Go to Phone > DSS Key > Line Key
- Add Call Park type to one of the Line keys. For example below, the PBX uses 80 for Call Park.
- Add one or more BLF keys. Using 81 and 82 as the values
- Click Confirm to save.

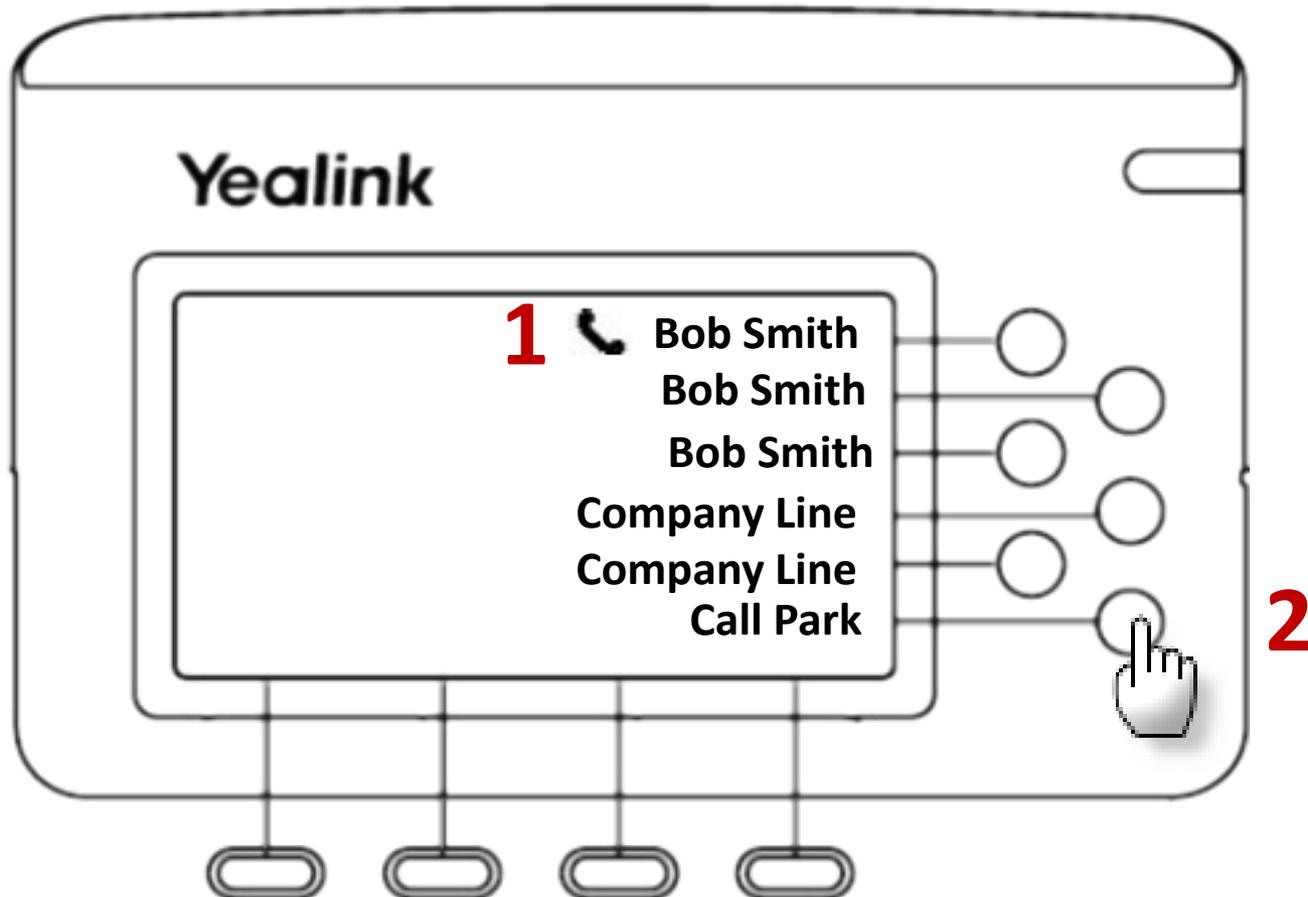

The Yealink T-28 now has the new keys in the display.

Here's how it would be used:

1. Bob Smith is talking with a customer.
2. Customer now wants to speak with Jim, so Bob "parks" the call. Customer now hears music on hold ...



3. The first “Company Line” will be blinking on all phones that have that BLF provisioned on them.

Jim, who’s in Andy Lee’s office, takes the call by pressing the button.
